PW-38 PEDESTRIAN SAFETY AT THE INTERSECTION OF VINEYARD STREET AND MARKET STREET (WAILUKU)

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 05-280, from Councilmember Pontanilla, transmitting a correspondence dated August 2, 2005 from Mona Harris regarding the safety of persons crossing the street at the intersection of Vineyard and Market Streets in Wailuku.

STATUS: The Committee may discuss the matter. The Committee may consider other related action including the filing of County Communication No. 05-280.

PW-22 GRANT OF A LICENSE TO USE COUNTY PROPERTY TO HALE MAHAOLU EONO SUBDIVISION (LAHAINA)

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 04-69, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, transmitting a proposed resolution to authorize a grant of license to

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Hale Mahaolu Eono Subdivision for the encroachment of a wall on approximately 100 square feet of County property along Lahainaluna Road in Lahaina, Maui.

STATUS:

Hale Mahaolu Eono was granted a license for the encroaching wall on March 19, 2004. The Committee may discuss potential remedies for the encroachment of the wall on County property, including the disposition of County property. The Committee may consider the filing of County Communication No. 04-69.

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
