PARTIAL CLOSURE OF HALI'A NAKOIA STREET (WAILUKU)

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 05-288, from the Council Chair, transmitting correspondence dated August 29, 2005, from Timothy Eleneki, Security Staff, and Stephen Yamada, Principal, Baldwin High School, requesting partial closure of Hali'a Nakoia Street during school hours (between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.) due to safety concerns.

STATUS: The Committee will view the roadway and the surrounding area. No legislative action will be taken.
