AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2001 BUDGET RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY (SPECIAL NEEDS ADVOCACY PROJECT - \$79,666; INCREASE OF 0.5 EQUIVALENT PERSONNEL)

DESCRIPTION:

By County Communication No. 01-49, the Prosecuting Attorney transmitted a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX A OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2001 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY". The purpose of the proposed bill is to increase the grant revenue for the Special Needs Advocacy Project by \$79,666 and increase the equivalent personnel by 0.5.

STATUS:

**BF-58 AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2001 BUDGET RELATING TO
THE DEPARTMENT OF THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY (INCREASE
OF 1.0 EQUIVALENT PERSONNEL IN THE GENERAL PROSECUTION PROGRAM)**

DESCRIPTION: By County Communication No. 01-48, the Prosecuting Attorney transmitted a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2001 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY". The purpose of the proposed bill is to create a new full-time Deputy Prosecuting Attorney position (1.0 equivalent personnel) in its General Prosecution Program.

STATUS: The item is being scheduled to allow the Committee to consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading. The Committee may also consider other related action, including the filing of County Communication No. 01-48.

**BF-54 PROPOSED AMENDMENT RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF
GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS (COUNTYWIDE SERVICE CENTER -
\$700,000)**

DESCRIPTION: By County Communication No. 01-30, the Director of Finance transmitted a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2866, BILL NO. 48 (2000), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI". The purpose of the proposed bill is to recognize \$700,000 for the Countywide Service Center in the Bond Ordinance. The funds for the Countywide Service Center was included in the Budget Ordinance, but excluded from the Bond Ordinance until details on the project could be provided. This request seeks approval for leasehold improvements for the Countywide Service Center.

STATUS: The Committee met on February 13, 2001 and deferred the matter pending further discussion. The item is being scheduled to allow the Committee to consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading. The Committee may also consider other related action, including the filing of County Communication No. 01-30.

BF-52 COMPREHENSIVE ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT (CAFR)

DESCRIPTION: By County Communication No. 01-28, the Council Chair transmitted the Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR) and management letter for the Fiscal Year ended June 30, 2000.
