### **PLANNING COMMISSION VOTING PROCEDURES**

**DESCRIPTION:**

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 99-246 from Councilmember Riki Hokama, transmitting copies of letters from a citizen on Lanai requesting that the matter of planning commission voting procedures be discussed. Among other things, the letters allege that at a November 18, 1998, meeting of the Lanai Planning Commission, an official vote of the Commission was reversed following a recess where lobbying of the Commissioners was permitted, but further public input was not.
