**PROPOSED BILL RENAMING THE WAR MEMORIAL BASEBALL
FIELD NO. 2 TO "TOSHIO 'TATA' FUJIMOTO FIELD"**

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 99-307, from the former Director of Public Works and Waste Management, transmitting a bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 12.40 OF THE MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO NAMES OF PUBLIC FACILITIES". The purpose of the proposed bill is to name the War Memorial Baseball Field No. 2 in honor of Toshio "Tata" Fujimoto.

PR-3 PROPOSED BILL RENAMING THE KAHULUI ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PARK TO THE “MAUI A.J.A. VETERAN’S BALLPARK”
