RULES GOVERNING CONDUCT AT COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 01-176, from the Council Chair, transmitting a memorandum from Cherrie-Ann K. Akina, dated May 5, 2001, relating to sanctions for the misuse of County parks and facilities. The Committee is also in receipt of a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13.04, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO PERMITS AND FEES." The purpose of the proposed bill is to grant the Director of Parks and Recreation the authority to impose sanctions for the misuse of County parks and facilities by permit holders.

STATUS:

At its meeting of October 3, 2001, the Committee deferred consideration of this item pending further discussion. The Committee will consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading. The Committee may also consider other related action, including the possible filing of County Communication No. 01-176.

PR-11 RENAMING PARKS AND FACILITIES

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 01-153, from the Committee Chair, relating to Chapter 2.38, Maui County Code, renaming of public facilities. The Committee is also in receipt of a memorandum from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, dated September 21, 2001, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.38, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO THE COMMISSION ON NAMING STREET, PARKS AND FACILITIES". The purposes of the proposed bill are the following:

1. Clarify the Council's authority to rename existing parks or facilities;
2. Permit parks or facilities to be named after organizations;
3. Establish criteria for the Commission on Naming Streets, Parks, and Facilities in reviewing requests for naming parks and facilities;
4. Expand the information required in requests for naming parks and facilities;
5. Establish authority to set up plaques in parks and facilities with names of persons and/or organizations, in-lieu of naming or renaming such parks and facilities;
6. Authorize inscription on such plaques by Council resolution; and
7. Incorporate related, non-substantive changes/amendments.

STATUS: At its meeting of September 19, 2001, the Committee deferred consideration of this item pending further discussion. The Committee requested that the Commission on Naming Streets, Parks and Facilities and the Director of Public Works and Waste Management review the proposed bill and transmit their recommendations to the Committee. The Committee will consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider other related action, including the possible filing of County Communication No. 01-153.
