PROPOSED BILL RELATING TO SMOKING IN RESTAURANTS

DESCRIPTION: By County Communication No. 02-133, the Acting Council Chair transmitted a draft bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO SMOKING IN RESTAURANTS". The purpose of the draft bill is to protect and promote public health by banning smoking in restaurants, subject to limited exceptions.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the draft bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider other related action, including the possible filing of County Communication No. 02-133.
