EMERGENCY PERMITTING

DESCRIPTION:

By County Communication No. 01-225, the Director of Public Works and Waste Management transmitted a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 16.26, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE AND RELATING TO EMERGENCY PERMITTING". The purpose of the proposed bill is to enable the County to issue building permits using emergency permitting procedures.

PWT-40 PROPOSED RESOLUTION GRANTING A NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENT TO CLARA BELLE REEVE FOR UNDERGROUND PRIVATE WATERLINE PURPOSES
