OUTDOOR LIGHTING

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 00-125, from the Council Chair, transmitting a letter from George Peabody, relating to glare and light from powerful floodlights. The Committee is also in receipt of a bill proposed by the Ad Hoc Maui Committee for Outdoor Lighting Standards, entitled "DRAFT MAUI OUTDOOR LIGHTING STANDARDS". The purpose of the proposed bill is to curtail and reverse the degradation of the nighttime visual environment by minimized light pollution, glare, and light trespass through regulation of the form and use of outdoor lighting and to conserve energy and resources while maintaining nighttime safety, utility, security and productivity.

STATUS:

At its meeting of May 2, 2001, the Committee deferred consideration of this item pending further discussion. The item is being scheduled to allow the Ad Hoc Maui Committee for Outdoor Lighting Standards to conduct a presentation on outdoor lighting. The Chair of the

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Committee intends to recommend deferral of the matter pending further discussion. The Committee may also consider other related action.

PWT-54 FEES AND POLICIES FOR CESSPOOL PUMPING

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. A Miscellaneous Communication dated May 21, 2001, from the County Clerk, referring the matter relating to fees and policies for cesspool pumping, along with a copy of the April 6, 2001 letter from the Director of Public Works and Waste Management (BF C.R. No 01-78, as amended).
2. County Communication No. 01-180, from Councilmember Alan Arakawa, relating to pumping of cesspools and septic tanks.

STATUS: The Committee will consider whether to recommend any legislative action. The Committee may consider other related action, including the possible filing of the Miscellaneous Communication and County Communication No. 01-180.

PWT-5 PROPOSED RESOLUTION ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF KUALAPU`U ROADWAY LOTS

DESCRIPTION: By County Communication No. 01-238, the Director of Public Works and Waste Management transmitted a proposed resolution entitled "ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF KUALAPU`U ROADWAY LOTS PURSUANT TO SECTION 3.44.015, MAUI COUNTY CODE". The purpose of the proposed resolution is to accept the dedication of roadway Lots 181, 182, 183, 216, 217, 218, 144, 145, 146, 147, 148, 149, 150 and 151, in conjunction with an experimental and demonstration housing project in Kualapu`u on Molokai.

STATUS: At its meeting of September 5, 2001, the Committee deferred consideration of this item pending further discussion. The item is being scheduled to allow the Committee to consider whether to recommend adoption of the proposed resolution with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider other related action, including the possible filing of County Communication No. 01-238.

PWT-46 DEDICATION OF ROADWAY LOT (TADATSUGU ENDO SUBDIVISION)

DESCRIPTION: By County Communication No. 01-267, the Director of Public Works and Waste Management transmitted a proposed resolution entitled "ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF ROAD WAY LOT PURSUANT TO SECTION 3.44.015, MAUI COUNTY CODE". The purpose of the proposed resolution is to accept the dedication of road widening Lot 298, along Upper Kimo Drive, in conjunction with the Tadatsugu Endo Subdivision. The Committee is in receipt of a revised resolution entitled "ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF ROADWAY LOT FROM TADATSUGU ENDO REVOCABLE LIVING TRUST, SITUATE IN KULA, MAUI, HAWAII, PURSUANT TO SECTION 3.44.015, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO ACQUISITION OF REAL PROPERTY". The resolution was revised to incorporate reference to the Tadatsugu Endo Revocable Living Trust and other nonsubstantive changes.
