PROPOSED RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ABANDONMENT AND SALE OF A PORTION OF A COUNTY ROADWAY BY POLO BEACH CLUB AOA

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 01-118, from the Mayor, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING THE ABANDONMENT AND SALE OF A PORTION OF A COUNTY ROADWAY PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 3.44.050 AND 3.44.070, MAUI COUNTY CODE, SECTIONS 264-1(d) AND 264-3, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES". The purpose of the proposed resolution is to authorize the County to sell a road remnant identified as TMK (2) 2-1-023:009, known as Keoneoio-Makena Road abutting the
