MAUNAOLU PLANTATION SUBDIVISION AND ITS RELATED LAND USE PROCESS

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 01-288, from Councilmember Jo Anne Johnson, relating to land use regulations applicable to Maunaolu Associates, L.L.C.'s proposed Maunaolu Plantation Subdivision.

STATUS:

The Committee will review alleged improprieties (allegations relating to the non-conformance of land use regulations) and consider whether to recommend any legislative action. The Committee may consider other related action, including the possible filing of County Communication No. 01-288.

PWT-32 OUTDOOR LIGHTING

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 00-125, from the Council Chair, transmitting an electronic-mail message from George Peabody of Molokai requesting that the Council consider legislative action to abate the trespassing of light.

STATUS: At its meetings of May 2, 2001 and October 3, 2001, the Committee deferred consideration of this item pending further discussion. The item is being scheduled to present to the Committee the proposed membership, objective and term for the establishment of a Subcommittee on Outdoor Lighting Standards, as recommended at its meeting of October 3. The Committee may also consider other related action, including the possible filing of County Communication No. 00-125.

PWT-38 GRANT OF LICENSE TO PACIFIC WAREHOUSE, INC.

DESCRIPTION: By County Communication No. 01-312, the Director of Public Works and Waste Management transmitted a proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING A GRANT OF A LICENSE TO USE COUNTY REAL PROPERTY TO PACIFIC WAREHOUSE, INC.". The purpose of the proposed resolution is to authorize a grant of a license to Pacific Warehouse, Inc. for a wall encroachment onto the County of Maui's right-of-way along Keala Place in Kihei.

STATUS: The Committee will consider whether to recommend adoption of the proposed resolution with or without revisions. The Committee may consider other related action, including the possible filing of County Communication No. 01-312.
