ITEM NO. 1: REQUEST FOR WAIVER OF PARK DEDICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE NORTH SHORE VILLAGE SUBDIVISION (PAIA)

The Committee assembled at 2:01 p.m. in the cul-de-sac of the North Shore Village Subdivision located at Hoku Place, Paia, Maui, off of Hana Highway.

Michele McLean, representing KRS Development, Inc., provided a brief overview of the park and pointed out the park's boundaries.

The Committee received public testimony from three members of the public who are residents of the North Shore Village Subdivision. Jean Manninen supported the idea of having a park for residents, but was concerned about non-residents parking their


