### **CONDITION OF THE BANYAN TREE**

**DESCRIPTION:**

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 01-151, from the Council Chair, transmitting a letter from a member of the public expressing concerns about the condition of the Banyan Tree in Lahaina (between Wharf and Front Streets, adjacent to the Old Lahaina Courthouse).

**STATUS:** At its meeting of October 4, 2001, the Council adopted a Resolution No. 01-167, entitled "SUPPORTING AN ENHANCED MAINTENANCE EFFORT FOR THE LAHAINA BANYAN TREE", as recommended by Committee Report No. 01-185. The purpose of the resolution is to urge the Mayor to provide the necessary funding to improve the care for the tree and develop a master plan that would help extend its life. The Committee may consider whether to recommend any legislative action. The Committee may also consider other related action, including the possible filing of County Communication No. 01-151.
