### **DESIGNATING A PARK IN THE WAIOLANI/WAIKAPU AREA**

**DESCRIPTION:**

The Committee is in receipt of a Miscellaneous Communication, dated May 15, 2002, from the County Clerk, referring the matter of the designation of a park in the Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan for the Waiolani/Waikapu area.

**STATUS:**

The Committee requested information relative to identifying a location for a park in this area. The Committee may consider whether to submit a recommendation to the Budget and Finance Committee for potential appropriation requests to be considered during budget deliberations for Fiscal Year 2004. In addition, the Committee may consider whether to recommend any legislative action. The Committee may also consider other related action, including the possible filing of the Miscellaneous Communication or referral of the matter to the Council Chair for the term beginning January 2, 2003.

**PR-4 NOISE AND NUISANCE CONCERNS AT THE WAILUKU COMMUNITY CENTER AND PAPOHAKU PARK**

**PR-8 FEES AND REGULATIONS FOR OCEAN RECREATIONAL ACTIVITY PERMITS**

**DESCRIPTION:** The Committee is in receipt of a Miscellaneous Communication, dated May 21, 2001, from the County Clerk, referring the matter relating to fees for ocean recreational activity permits (Chapter 5.24, Maui County Code).

The Committee may also consider other related action, including the possible filing of the Miscellaneous Communication or referral of the matter to the Council Chair for the term beginning January 2, 2003.
