COMMERCIAL SIGNS ON PRIVATE PROPERTY

DESCRIPTION:

By County Communication No. 00-281, the Planning Director transmitted a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 16.12A, MAUI COUNTY CODE, AND AMENDING TITLE 16, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO THE REGULATION OF COMMERCIAL SIGNS ON PRIVATE PROPERTY". The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Maui County Code to address complaints and concerns relating to the interpretation of existing provisions relating to commercial signs on private property. The Department of the Corporation Counsel subsequently submitted a revised proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 16.12A, MAUI COUNTY CODE, AND AMENDING TITLE 16, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO THE REGULATION OF SIGNS". The revised proposed bill retains provisions relating to political campaign signs in Chapter 16.12A and relocates provisions deleted from Chapter 16.12A to Chapter 16.13. At its meeting of March 1, 2002, the Council recommitted Public Works and Transportation Committee Report No. 02-30, recommending passage of the proposed bill, as revised, on first reading and filing of the communication.

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STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the revised proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider other related action, including the possible filing of County Communication No. 00-281 and/or Public Works and Transportation Committee Report No. 02-30.

PWT-42 RENAMING A PORTION OF OLD MAKENA ROAD AKA MAKENA KEONEOIO ROAD

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 01-117, from the Director of Public Works and Waste Management, relating to the Commission on Naming Streets, Parks and Facilities' recommendation to deny a request to rename a portion of Old Makena Road, aka Makena Keoneoio Road, to Kukahiko Road.

STATUS: At its meeting of July 2, 2001, the Committee deferred consideration of this item pending further discussion. The Committee may consider whether any legislative action is warranted on this item. The Committee may also consider other related action, including the possible filing of County Communication No. 01-117.

PWT-32 OUTDOOR LIGHTING

DESCRIPTION: By County Communication No. 00-125, the Council Chair transmitted correspondence from George Peabody of Molokai requesting that the Council consider legislative action to abate the trespassing of light.

STATUS: At its meeting of December 5, 2001, the Committee established the Subcommittee on Outdoor Lighting Standards (Subcommittee) to provide recommendations on the desired lighting standards for Maui County. The matter was deferred pending receipt of recommendations from the Subcommittee. At the request of the Subcommittee, the Committee will consider extending the Subcommittee's term. The Committee may also consider other related action.

PWT-7 AUTHORIZING A GRANT OF A LICENSE TO USE COUNTY REAL PROPERTY ALONG MAMALU PLACE AND MAOHU STREET, MAKAWAO

DESCRIPTION: By County Communication No. 02-21, the Director of Public Works and Waste Management transmitted a proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING A GRANT OF A LICENSE TO USE COUNTY REAL PROPERTY IN MAKAWAO, MAUI, HAWAII TO JOEL ANTHONY KENNEY". The purpose of the proposed resolution is to authorize a grant of license to Joel Anthony Kenney to use County real property along Mamalu Place and Maohu Street, Makawao for the encroachment of a wall and walkway on the County right-of-way.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend adoption of the proposed resolution, with or without revisions. The Committee may consider other related action, including the possible filing of County Communication No. 02-21.

PWT-10 GRANT OF LICENSE TO CASTLE & COOKE RESORTS, LLC

DESCRIPTION: By County Communication No. 02-57, the Director of Public Works and Waste Management transmitted a proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING A GRANT OF A LICENSE TO USE COUNTY REAL PROPERTY TO CASTLE & COOKE RESORTS, LLC". The purpose of

the proposed resolution is to authorize a grant of a license to Castle & Cooke Resorts, LLC to use County real property along Sixth Street, Lanai for the encroachment of a roof on the County right-of-way.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend adoption of the proposed resolution, with or without revisions. The Committee may consider other related action, including the possible filing of County Communication No. 02-57.

PWT-15 GRANT OF A LICENSE TO RANCHO MANANA CLUB LIMITED PARTNERSHIP

DESCRIPTION: By County Communication No. 01-329, the Director of Public Works and Waste Management transmitted a proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING A GRANT OF A LICENSE TO USE COUNTY REAL PROPERTY TO RANCHO MANANA CLUB LIMITED PARTNERSHIP". The purpose of the proposed resolution is to authorize a grant of a license to Rancho Manana Golf Club Limited Partnership to use County real property along Keoneoio Makena Road for the encroachment of a rock wall on the County right-of-way.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend adoption of the proposed resolution, with or without revisions. The Committee may consider other related action, including the possible filing of County Communication No. 01-329.
