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**U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT  
(HUD) NEIGHBORHOOD STABILIZATION PROGRAM**

**DESCRIPTION:**

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 09-46, from Councilmember Wayne K. Nishiki, relating to the matter of funding to help stabilize Maui County's communities and to provide affordable and workforce housing in Maui County.

**STATUS:**

The Committee may discuss policy issues relating to the Neighborhood Stabilization Program, which provides emergency assistance to state and local governments to acquire and redevelop foreclosed properties that might otherwise become sources of abandonment and blight within their communities.
