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COUNTY'S INTEGRATED SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 09-22, from the Director of Environmental Management, relating to the County of Maui's Integrated Solid Waste Management Plan. The purpose of the plan is to comply with Chapter 342G, Hawaii Revised Statutes, which requires that each County submit a revised Integrated Solid Waste Management Plan every five years.

STATUS: The Committee may hear a presentation of the various components of the plan. No legislative action is required. The Committee may consider the filing of County Communication No. 09-22 and other related action.

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
