COMMERCIAL OCEAN RECREATIONAL ACTIVITY

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 09-216, from the Director of Parks and Recreation, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13.04, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO COMMERCIAL OCEAN RECREATIONAL ACTIVITY". The purposes of the proposed bill are to clarify the nontransferability provision and allow Commercial Ocean Recreational Activity permits to be transferred to a spouse, reciprocal beneficiary, or child of the permit holder; to delete the definition of "Ocean recreational activity"; and to insert a definition for "Reciprocal beneficiaries".
