### **BILL TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON WAILANI STREET, WAILUKU (SECTION 10.48.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING)**

**DESCRIPTION:**

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 09-232, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.48.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING ON WAILANI STREET, WAILUKU". The purpose of the proposed bill is to prohibit parking on a portion of Wailani Street in Wailuku, between East Vineyard Street and Nani Street.
