BILL TO PROHIBIT PARKING IN MOLOKAI DISTRICT

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 09-231, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.48.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO PROHIBITED PARKING IN MOLOKAI DISTRICT". The purpose of the proposed bill is to prohibit parking on both sides of Alohi Street, from its intersection with Kamoi Street for a distance of 200 feet to the east.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication No. 09-231 and other related action.

IM-35 TRAFFIC SAFETY MEASURES IN THE AREA OF DORIS TODD MEMORIAL CHRISTIAN SCHOOL (PAIA)

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 09-325, from the Council Chair, transmitting a letter from Quinn Gonzalez, relating to traffic safety measures in the area of Doris Todd Memorial Christian School. The purpose of the letter is to highlight the need to address possible additional traffic safety measures in the vicinity of Doris Todd Memorial Christian School, located at 519 Baldwin Avenue, Paia, Maui, due to numerous vehicular accidents.

STATUS: The Committee may discuss information relating to vehicle safety concerns in the vicinity of Doris Todd Memorial Christian School. The Committee may consider the filing of County Communication No. 09-325 and other related action.

IM-28 BILL TO PROHIBIT VEHICLES WITH A GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT GREATER THAN 10,000 POUNDS FROM OPERATING ON VINEYARD STREET, WAILUKU

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 09-245, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.68.110, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PROHIBITING OR REGULATING THE USE OF ROADWAYS BY CERTAIN CLASSES OR KINDS OF TRAFFIC". The purpose of the proposed bill is to prohibit vehicles with a gross vehicle weight greater than 10,000 pounds from operating on Vineyard Street, Wailuku; and to exempt buses providing County-funded transportation services.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication No. 09-245 and other related action.
