I. HEARINGS BEFORE THE BOARD:

A. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2010-05, PLEA: NO CONTEST

In the matter of the accusation against JUCA MEXICAN RESTAURANT INC. dba JUCA MEXICAN RESTAURANT, Dispenser General License No. 344, 300 Maalaea Road, Building 1, Shops H, I & J, Maalaea, Maui, Hawaii.

- Count 1. On April 8, 2009 at approximately 3:50 p.m., JUCA MEXICAN RESTAURANT INC. dba JUCA MEXICAN RESTAURANT, a dispenser general licensee, did, through its employee, sell, serve, or furnish liquor to a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.
- Count 2. On April 8, 2009 at approximately 3:50 p.m., JUCA MEXICAN RESTAURANT INC. dba JUCA MEXICAN RESTAURANT, a dispenser general licensee, did, through its employee, fail to properly check the identification of a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 08-101-61(c) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.
- Count 3. On April 8, 2009 at approximately 4:00 p.m., JUCA MEXICAN RESTAURANT INC. dba JUCA MEXICAN RESTAURANT, a dispenser general licensee, did fail to have an on-duty employee duly approved by the director in active charge of the premises during all times that such premises was open for business, contrary to Section 08-101-70(a) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

B. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2010-07, PLEA: NO CONTEST

In the matter of the accusation against CLARK ENTERPRISES, INC. dba PARAGON SAILING CHARTERS, Tour or Cruise Vessel License No. 210, Maalaea Harbor, #72, Maalaea, Maui, Hawaii.

Count 1. On May 5, 2009 at approximately 12:31 p.m., CLARK ENTERPRISES, INC. dba PARAGON SAILING CHARTERS, a tour or cruise vessel licensee, did fail to have an on-duty employee duly approved by the director in active charge of the premises during all times that such premises was open for business, contrary to Section 08-101-70(a) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.
