ADOPTION OF 2008 NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE[®] WITH LOCAL AMENDMENTS

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 09-244, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 16.18A, MAUI COUNTY CODE, AND ESTABLISHING A NEW CHAPTER 16.18B, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO THE ELECTRICAL CODE". The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Maui County Code by repealing Chapter 16.18A and adding a new Chapter 16.18B, which incorporates the 2008 National Electrical Code[®] with local amendments.

STATUS:

The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication No. 09-244 and other related action.

IM-23 BILL RELATING TO PERMITTING REQUIREMENTS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF LANAI ENCLOSURES

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. 09-217, from Councilmember Jo Anne Johnson, transmitting a draft bill to provide exemptions from the Uniform Building Code for the construction of lanai enclosures in which no square footage is added to the existing structure.
2. Correspondence dated August 18, 2009, from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 16.26.106, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE AND CONSTRUCTION OF LANAI ENCLOSURES". The purpose of the proposed bill is to provide exemptions from the Uniform Building Code for the construction of lanai enclosures in which no square footage is added to the existing structure.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication No. 09-217 and other related action.

IM-29 BILL TO EXEMPT COUNTY-INITIATED OR COUNTY CO-SPONSORED PROJECTS FROM SUBDIVISION REQUIREMENTS

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. 09-260, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a proposed bill to exempt County-initiated or County co-sponsored infrastructure projects from subdivision requirements.
2. Correspondence dated November 18, 2009, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a revised proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 18.04, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO SUBDIVISION GENERAL PROVISIONS". The purpose of the revised proposed bill is to exempt specified County-initiated or County co-sponsored infrastructure projects from subdivision requirements.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the revised proposed bill on first reading, with or without further revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication No. 09-260 and other related action.
