PC-19 SMALL WIND ENERGY SYSTEMS

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 10-11, from Council Vice-Chair Michael J. Molina, transmitting a draft resolution entitled "REFERRING TO THE LANAI, MAUI AND MOLOKAI PLANNING COMMISSIONS A DRAFT BILL AMENDING CHAPTER 19, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO SMALL WIND ENERGY SYSTEMS". The purpose of the draft resolution is to refer to the planning commissions a draft bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 19, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO SMALL WIND ENERGY SYSTEMS". The purpose of the draft bill is to establish small wind energy systems as permitted uses in all zoning districts, subject to various standards.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend adoption of the draft resolution, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication No. 10-11 and other related action.

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

Correspondence dated December 14, 2009, from the Planning Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.80B.030, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO THE MAUI ISLAND PLAN". The purpose of the proposed bill is to adopt the Maui Island Plan, pursuant to Chapter 2.80B, Maui County Code, including the following elements: an island-wide land use strategy, a Water Element, a Nearshore Ecosystem Element, an Implementation Program, and Milestones. The proposed bill's Exhibit B is to be the consolidated draft Maui Island Plan, subject to revisions recommended by the Planning Committee.

STATUS: The Committee may review, revise, and recommend the approval of the following components of the consolidated draft Maui Island Plan: Introduction (and other prefatory documents), Chapter 1 (Population), Chapter 2 (Heritage Resources), Chapter 3 (Natural Hazards), and Chapter 4 (Economic Development). Other components will not be considered.
