NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Council of the County of Maui, State of Hawaii, on Thursday, April 29, 2010, beginning at 6:30 p.m., or soon thereafter, in the Council Chamber, 8th Floor, Kalana O Maui Building, 200 South High Street, Wailuku, Maui, Hawaii, for the purpose of considering the following:

THE REAL PROPERTY TAX RATES FOR THE
COUNTY OF MAUI FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
JULY 1, 2010 TO JUNE 30, 2011

Pursuant to Chapter 3.48 of the Maui County Code, the following real property tax rates are proposed:

Table with 3 columns: CLASSIFICATION, LAND (Per \$1,000) Range of Tax Rates, BUILDING (Per \$1,000) Range of Tax Rates. Rows A-K include categories like Improved Residential, Apartment, Commercial, Industrial, Agricultural, Conservation, Hotel & Resort, Time Share, Unimproved Residential, Homeowner, and Commercialized Residential.

The foregoing schedule of rates will be considered at the public hearing. The final rates for each property class may be fixed within the proposed ranges.


Each testifier shall be allowed to speak for three minutes. If additional time is requested, the testifier shall be allowed one minute to conclude their testimony. No further oral testimony by the testifier shall be permitted. An individual's request to testify shall be deemed withdrawn if the individual does not answer when called to testify.

Written testimony must be submitted, e-mailed (county.clerk@mauicounty.us), or faxed (808-270-7171) to the Office of the County Clerk 24 hours prior to the public hearing so copies can be provided to the Council Members. If written testimony is submitted at the public hearing, 15 copies are requested.

Public access to the County Building will be available from the first floor entrance. Individuals planning to attend the public hearing are invited to utilize the lower parking lot adjacent to the building.

Individuals who intend to attend the public hearing and who have disabilities requiring special assistance should call the Office of the County Clerk at 270-7748, at least three days in advance.
