MAUI COUNTY PUBLIC TRANSIT SYSTEM (MAUI BUS)

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 10-109, from the Director of Transportation, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO PUBLIC TRANSIT".
