Chair and Members:

Your Infrastructure Management Committee, having met on November 30, 2009, and June 7, 2010, makes reference to County Communication No. 09-325, from Danny A. Mateo, Council Chair, transmitting a letter from Quinn Gonzalez, relating to traffic safety measures in the area of Doris Todd Memorial Christian School, located at 519 Baldwin Avenue, Paia, Maui.

The Director of Public Works stated that speed feedback monitors and pedestrian-activated crossing lights have been installed in front of the school. The Department determined, however, that speed bumps and guardrails were inappropriate safety measures for this particular area.

The Wailuku Patrol Division and the Traffic Section of the Department of Police performed traffic education and enforcement efforts to target speeding and reckless driving in the vicinity of the school. The representative of the Department stated that the safety devices and increased police presence resulted in a drop in the issuance of tickets and a reduction in the number of calls for service in this area.

Your Committee was satisfied with the departments' actions in response to its request to consider implementing additional safety measures in the vicinity of the school.

Your Committee voted 7-0 to recommend filing of the communication. Committee Chair Medeiros, Vice-Chair Pontanilla, and members Baisa, Kaho`ohalahala, Mateo, Molina, and Victorino voted "aye".

Your Infrastructure Management Committee **RECOMMENDS** that County Communication No. 09-325 be FILED.
