Chair and Members:

Your Economic Development, Agriculture, and Recreation Committee, having met on July 1, 2010, makes reference to the following:

1. County Communication No. 09-324, from the Director of Parks and Recreation, transmitting a report entitled "PARK DEDICATION REQUIREMENT SEMI ANNUAL REPORT" for the period of April 1, 2009 through September 30, 2009; and
2. County Communication No. 10-92, from the Director of Parks and Recreation, transmitting a report entitled "PARK DEDICATION REQUIREMENT SEMI ANNUAL REPORT" for the period of October 1, 2009 through March 31, 2010.

Your Committee notes that pursuant to Section 18.16.320(L), Maui County Code, the Director of Parks and Recreation shall transmit to the Council a semi-annual report regarding park dedications for each community plan area within 30 days after the end of the first and third quarter of the fiscal year.

A representative from the Department of Parks and Recreation provided an overview of the three projects identified in the reports (Huelo Hui Partition II; Ka `Ono `Ulu Estates, Phase V; and Kamalii Alayna Subdivision). The subdividers of the Huelo Hui Partition II and Ka `Ono `Ulu Estates, Phase V projects provided funds in lieu of providing or dedicating land to satisfy the subdivision's park dedication requirements. The subdivider of the Kamalii Alayna Subdivision satisfied the park dedication requirements by providing funds as well as a privately owned and maintained park of 36,072 square feet.

Your Committee again requested that future reports include the total park assessment funds that are available by community plan area.


