**WAIVING CERTAIN PARK DEDICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE  
LOKAHI KUHUA SUBDIVISION (LAHAINA)**

**DESCRIPTION:**

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 05-350, from the Director of Parks and Recreation, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "APPROVING THE WAIVER OF CERTAIN PARK REQUIREMENTS FOR A PRIVATELY OWNED AND MAINTAINED PARK PURSUANT TO SECTION 18.16.320, MAUI COUNTY CODE, FOR THE LOKAHI KUHUA SUBDIVISION, LAHAINA, MAUI, HAWAII". The purpose of the proposed resolution is to approve the waiver of the requirement to provide comfort stations and a parking area for a privately owned and maintained park, comprising approximately 4,308 square feet in the Lokahi Kuhua Subdivision, and located in the vicinity of the intersection of Paeohi Street and Kopili Street, Lahaina, Maui.

**EAR-2                    ACCEPTING LAND DEDICATED FOR PARK AND PLAYGROUND PURPOSES AND WAIVING CERTAIN PARK DEDICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE WAILUKU COUNTRY ESTATES SUBDIVISION**

**DESCRIPTION:** The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 06-193, from the Director of Parks and Recreation, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "ACCEPTING LAND DEDICATED FOR PARK AND PLAYGROUND PURPOSES AND WAIVER OF COMFORT STATION PURSUANT TO SECTION 18.16.320, MAUI COUNTY CODE". The purposes of the proposed resolution are to: (1) accept the dedication of a park located in the Wailuku Country Estates Subdivision, comprised of approximately 98,595 square feet, and located in the vicinity of the intersection of Maoi Street and Hewahewa Drive, Wailuku, Maui; and (2) approve the waiver of the requirements to provide comfort stations in the subject park.
