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## INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS NEEDED TO INITIATE PHASING OUT THE USE OF INJECTION WELLS

### DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 11-54, from Councilmember Cochran, referring the matter relating to infrastructure improvements needed to initiate phasing out the use of injection wells.

### STATUS:

The Committee may conduct a panel discussion and receive presentations regarding the County's phasing out the use of injection wells, consistent with the Countywide Policy Plan. Speakers may include the Mayor, department directors, and environmental scientists from the Administration and the private sector. The Committee may discuss related policy issues. No legislative action will be taken.

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**IM-11(3) COMMITTEE'S PRIORITIES AND PROCEDURES; PRESENTATIONS FROM COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCIES (ORIENTATION WORKSHOP BY THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION)**
