## SOLAR ENERGY FACILITIES AS PERMITTED USES IN THE AGRICULTURAL ZONING DISTRICT

### DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of Committee Report No. 11-10 (recommitted), recommending passage on first reading of a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH SOLAR ENERGY FACILITIES AS PERMITTED USES IN THE AGRICULTURAL ZONING DISTRICT". The purpose of the proposed bill is to establish solar energy facilities as a permitted use in the Agricultural District.

**PC-29****PLANNING PERMITTING STREAMLINING PACKAGE**

**DESCRIPTION:** The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 10-252, from the Planning Director, transmitting the following:

1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 19.32, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO PLANNED DEVELOPMENT". The purposes of the proposed bill are to: (a) establish a three-step approval process for tract development of certain parcels of at least three acres; and (b) authorize the applicable planning commission to waive its opportunity to review and take final action on the Step III approval ("unified site and building program"), thereby allowing the Planning Director to take final action.
2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 19.36A, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO OFF-STREET PARKING AND LOADING". The purposes of the proposed bill are to: (a) establish off-street parking requirements for the Service Business Residential Zoning District; (b) transfer approval authority for off-street parking from the planning commissions to the Planning Director; and (c) establish that individually striped parking spaces are required when off-street paved parking areas are provided for five or more automobiles, in place of the existing requirement for striping of off-street parking areas for three or more automobiles.
3. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 19.40, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO CONDITIONAL PERMITS". The purpose of the proposed bill is to allow the Planning Director, instead of the Council by ordinance, to approve certain Conditional Permit amendments and time extensions.
4. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 19.45, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO PROJECT DISTRICT PROCESSING REGULATIONS". The purposes of the proposed bill are to: (a) allow concurrent processing of Phase I and Phase II Project District applications; and (b) allow the Planning Director, instead of the planning commissions, to approve non-substantive revisions to Phase II preliminary site approvals and Phase III final site plans.
