Should the above three Directors appointed by the Mayor be confirmed by the Council? Their removal be confirmed by the Council?

91-10-6: Rules of the Department of Water Supply for adoption be changed from 2/3 vote of its entire membership for disapproval, or the council may disapprove rules by resolution?

91-10-8: Should a department of Waste Management be established?

91-10-10: Should a Department of Housing be established?

Interviewed department heads and some questions have arisen that need full Commission decision.

Prosecuting Attorney, Larry Butrick. Investigators do not have police power. Honolulu reinstated it in their charter. He asks that we do so (refer to 91-16); further the three year residency should be removed.

Director of Finance. Suggest the following changes:

8-4-3, Paragraph 7 "prepare and issue warrants" to add "and checks".

8-4-3, Paragraph 13 should be changed to reflect there is only one bond covering everybody.

9-13: We recommend same verbage which would make an audit by an independent firm a must in the event of a change-over in administration.

Public Safety Commission: Doc Evans and Yvonne Bonnie Tuell recommend a change from Public Safety Commission to Fire Commission. Refer to proposed changes.

8-7-2; 8-7-3; 8-7-4

Ron Davis proposes five years experience in fire control "in the Maui Fire Department".

Liquor Commission:

- a. Grade of Director questioned.
- b. Should Salary Commission be responsible for Directors' salary like other department heads?

Board of Water Supply: Public testimony by James Smith suggesting reverting back to former system.
