NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to Subsection 3.48.565(B) of the Maui County Code, that the public hearing held by the Council of the County of Maui, on Thursday, May 5, 2011, on the proposed Real Property Tax Rates for the County of Maui, effective July 1, 2011, will be reconvened in the Council Chamber, 8th Floor, Kalana O Maui Building, 200 South High Street, Wailuku, Maui, on Monday, May 23, 2011, beginning at 11:00 a.m. or soon thereafter, for the purpose of considering the following proposed resolution:

ADOPTING THE REAL PROPERTY TAX RATES
FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI,
EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011

Pursuant to Sections 3.48.565 through 3.48.575 of the Maui County Code, the real property tax rates per one thousand dollars of net taxable assessed valuation for each classification of real property, effective July 1, 2011, shall be set as follows:

B. Apartment	\$5.50	\$5.50
C. Commercial	\$6.25	\$6.25
D. Industrial	\$7.00	\$7.00
E. Agricultural	\$5.80	\$5.80
F. Conservation	\$5.60	\$5.60
G. Hotel & Resort	\$9.00	\$9.00
H. Time Share	\$15.00	\$15.00
I. Homeowner	\$2.50	\$2.50
J. Commercialized Residential	\$4.20	\$4.20

Copies of the proposed resolution are on file in the Office of the County Clerk, 7th Floor, Kalana O Maui Building, 200 South High Street, Wailuku, Maui, for use and examination by the public during regular business hours.

Each testifier shall be allowed to speak for three minutes. If additional time is requested, the testifier shall be allowed one minute to conclude their testimony. No further oral testimony by the testifier shall be permitted. An individual's request to testify shall be deemed withdrawn if the individual does not answer when called to testify.

Written testimony must be submitted, e-mailed (county.clerk@mauicounty.us), or faxed (808-270-7171) to the Office of the County Clerk 24 hours prior to the public hearing so copies can be provided to the Council Members. If written testimony is submitted at the public hearing, 15 copies are requested.
