ORAL OR WRITTEN TESTIMONY on any agenda item will be accepted. Each testifier shall be allowed to speak for three minutes on each item. **IM-19 BILL TO ESTABLISH A CROSSWALK ON A PORTION OF KANANI
ROAD IN KIHEI**

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 11-140, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.60.042, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CROSSWALK ON A PORTION OF KANANI ROAD IN KIHEI". The purpose of the proposed bill is to establish a crosswalk on a portion of Kanani Road in Kihei, approximately 450 feet east of South Kihei Road.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication No. 11-140 and other related action.
