## DONATION OF RECYCLING EQUIPMENT FROM THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

### DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 11-195, from the Director of Environmental Management, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF DONATION OF VARIOUS ITEMS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, STATE OF HAWAII, TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT, COUNTY OF MAUI, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 3.56, MAUI COUNTY CODE". The purpose of the proposed resolution is to accept an offer from the Department of Health, State of Hawaii, to donate

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recycling equipment for use at the Lanai Recycling Center and for other County of Maui recycling programs.

**IM-24 COUNTY PARKING LOT ON BALDWIN AVENUE IN PAIA**

The purpose of the proposed bill is to establish two-hour parking at the County parking lot on Baldwin Avenue in Paia, Maui, Hawaii, from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

**IM-4 BILL RELATING TO DEVELOPMENT ON STEEP TERRAIN**

**DESCRIPTION:** The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 11-23, from Councilmember Michael P. Victorino, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 20.08, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO DEVELOPMENT ON STEEP TERRAIN". The purpose of the proposed bill is to minimize geological and hydrological hazards associated with the development of hillside areas by requiring an engineering slope hazard report in specified instances.
