**AUTHORIZING PARKS SECURITY OFFICERS TO ISSUE PARKING CITATIONS AND PROHIBITING UNAUTHORIZED COMMERCIAL ACTIVITY IN PARKS**

**DESCRIPTION:**

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 10-270, from the Director of Parks and Recreation, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 10, MAUI COUNTY CODE, AND TITLE 13, MAUI COUNTY CODE, AUTHORIZING PARKS SECURITY OFFICERS TO ISSUE PARKING CITATIONS AND PROHIBITING UNAUTHORIZED COMMERCIAL ACTIVITY IN PARKS". The purpose of the proposed bill is to

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enable parks security officers to issue citations within park boundaries for illegal commercial activities and parking violations.

**FEES AND DEPOSITS FOR USE OF PARKS AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES FOR TYPE II AND TYPE II(R) COUNTY CO-SPONSORED ACTIVITIES**

**DESCRIPTION:** The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 12-6, from the Director of Parks and Recreation, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 13.04.080, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO FEES AND DEPOSITS". The purpose of the proposed bill is to allow senior citizen organizations, adult-supervised youth organizations, and persons with disabilities organizations to engage in Type II and Type II(R) County co-sponsored activities with no charge for the use of parks and recreational facilities.
