Count 1. On July 2, 2011 at approximately 7:01 p.m., IZAKAYA MATSU LLC dba IZAKAYA MATSU, a restaurant general licensee, did, through its employee, sell, serve, or furnish liquor to a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

B. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2012-13, PLEA: GUILTY

In the matter of the accusation against HO'OMAKA, INC. dba MAUNALOA GENERAL STORE, Retail General License No. 385, 200 Maunaloa Highway, Maunaloa, Molokai, Hawaii.

Count 1. On July 8, 2011 at approximately 10:22 a.m., HO'OMAKA, INC. dba MAUNALOA GENERAL STORE, a retail general licensee, did, through its employee, sell or furnish liquor to a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

C. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2012-14, PLEA: NO CONTEST

In the matter of the accusation against KAA NAPALI BOYS CLUB, LLC dba CANE & TARO, Restaurant General License No. 163, 2435 Kaanapali Parkway, Unit I-01, Kaanapali, Maui, Hawaii.

- Count 1. On July 9, 2011 at approximately 8:52 p.m., KAA NAPALI BOYS CLUB, LLC dba CANE & TARO, a restaurant general licensee, did, through its employee, sell, serve, or furnish liquor to a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.
