CHAPTER 18.04, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO SUBDIVISION GENERAL PROVISIONS

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 12-79, from the Director of Public Works and the Planning Director, transmitting the following:

1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 3760, RELATING TO TITLE 18, SUBDIVISION GENERAL PROVISIONS TO DELETE THE SUNSET PROVISION OF ORDINANCE NO. 3760". The purpose of the proposed bill is to remove the two-year sunset provision of Ordinance 3760, allowing Ordinance 3760 to remain in

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effect rather than expire on August 12, 2012. Ordinance 3760 amended Chapter 18.04, Maui County Code, to authorize the Director of Public Works, after consultation with the Planning Director, to approve a proposed subdivision, provided that land uses within the subdivision are “consistent” with – even if they do not necessarily “conform” to – the County General Plan, the community plan, zoning, and the State land use district classification.

2. A proposed bill entitled “A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 18.04.030, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO SUBDIVISIONS”. The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Subsection 18.04.030(C), Maui County Code, to provide that only one interim-zoned large lot shall be permitted from each interim-zoned area in a parcel.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bills on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 12-79 and other related action.

IM-49 BILL ESTABLISHING CROSSWALKS ON KANALOA AVENUE AND WELLS STREET (WAILUKU)

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 12-96, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a proposed bill entitled “A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.60.042, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CROSSWALK ON A PORTION OF KANALOA AVENUE AND ON A PORTION OF WELLS STREET, WAILUKU, MAUI, HAWAII”. The purpose of the proposed bill is to allow the installation of crosswalks on Kanaloa Avenue fronting baseball field 2 of the War Memorial Complex and on Wells Street in the vicinity of the tennis courts at Wells Park, Wailuku, Maui, Hawaii.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 12-96 and other related action.

IM-48 BILL AMENDING SECTION 14.25A.130, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO WASTEWATER

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 12-64, from the Director of Environmental Management, transmitting a proposed bill entitled “A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14.25A.130, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO WASTEWATER”. The purpose of the proposed bill is to allow the Director of Environmental Management the discretion to modify or eliminate the requirement for a property sewer service manhole.
