M-1 LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 12-118, from the Planning Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 19, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO M-1 LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT". The purpose of the proposed bill is to update and simplify the M-1 Light Industrial District ordinance, including (1) clarifying that dwelling units located above or below the first floor of a building and apartments are permitted residential uses; (2) establishing "Production facility, multimedia" as a permitted use and defining the term in Title 19; and (3) establishing other permitted uses, accessory uses and structures, development standards, and the Planning Director's rule-making authority.

PC-36 M-2 HEAVY INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 12-119, from the Planning Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 19.26, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO M-2 HEAVY INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT". The purpose of the proposed bill is to update and simplify the M-2 Heavy Industrial District ordinance by establishing permitted uses, accessory uses and structures, special uses, development standards, and the Planning Director's rule-making authority.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 12-119 and other related action.

PC-37 M-3 RESTRICTED INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 12-120, from the Planning Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 19, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO M-3 RESTRICTED INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT". The purpose of the proposed bill is to establish a new M-3 Restricted Industrial District for manufacturing and nuisance industries that permits uses including the manufacturing, processing, storage, or treatment of goods from raw materials, and specifically excludes general retail and office uses.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 12-120 and other related action.
