To ensure its distribution prior to the meeting, written testimony must be received in the Office of Council Services at least 24 hours prior to the meeting; provided, that if a meeting will be held on a Monday, written testimony shall be received by 12:00 noon on the business day preceding the meeting. If written testimony is submitted at the meeting, 16 copies are requested to ensure distribution at the meeting.

PERMITTING TRANSIENT VACATION RENTALS IN PLANNED DEVELOPMENTS APPROVED ON OR BEFORE APRIL 20, 1981

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication 12-17, from Councilmember Elle Cochran, submitting a proposed resolution to refer to the planning commissions a proposed bill permitting transient vacation rentals in planned developments that were approved on or before April 20, 1981.
2. Correspondence dated September 10, 2012, from Planning Committee Chair Donald G. Couch, Jr., transmitting a revised proposed resolution entitled "REFERRING TO THE MAUI PLANNING COMMISSION A PROPOSED BILL AMENDING SECTION 19.32.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO PLANNED DEVELOPMENTS, AND SECTION 19.37.010,

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MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO TRANSIENT VACATION RENTALS". The purpose of the resolution is to transmit to the Maui Planning Commission a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 19.32.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO PLANNED DEVELOPMENTS, AND SECTION 19.37.010, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO TRANSIENT VACATION RENTALS". The purpose of the proposed bill is to permit transient vacation rentals in planned developments that were approved on or before April 20, 1981, with certain restrictions.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend adoption of the revised proposed resolution, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 12-17 and other related action.

PC-10 CULTURAL RESOURCES COMMISSION AND MAUI COUNTY HISTORIC DISTRICTS

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 11-142, from the Planning Director, transmitting, in response to Resolution 10-43, a summary of the Maui, Molokai, and Lanai Planning Commissions' comments on a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.88, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO THE CULTURAL RESOURCES COMMISSION, AND TITLE 19, ARTICLE III, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO MAUI COUNTY HISTORIC DISTRICTS". The purpose of the proposed bill is to protect and preserve Maui County's historic districts by (1) clarifying the authority of the Maui County Cultural Resources Commission; and (2) providing protection of view planes, historic buildings and structures, and large trees within historic districts.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions, the filing of County Communication 11-142, and other related action.
