A. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2012-38, PLEA: GUILTY

In the matter of the accusation against GERARD'S, INC. dba GERARD'S RESTAURANT, Restaurant General License No. 052, 174 Lahainaluna Road, Lahaina, Maui, Hawaii.

Count 1. On August 20, 2011 at approximately 7:19 p.m., GERARD'S, INC. dba GERARD'S RESTAURANT, a restaurant general licensee, did, through its employee, sell, serve, or furnish liquor to a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

B. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2012-39, PLEA: GUILTY

In the matter of the accusation against L.L.B. ENTERPRISE LLC dba STEEL HORSE SALOON, Dispenser General License No. 042, 1234 Lower Main Street, Wailuku, Maui, Hawaii.

Count 1. On September 17, 2011 at approximately 8:04 p.m., L.L.B. ENTERPRISE LLC dba STEEL HORSE SALOON, a dispenser general licensee, did, through its employee, sell, serve, or furnish liquor to a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

C. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2012-41, PLEA: NO CONTEST

In the matter of the accusation against SUSHI PARADISE, INC. dba SUSHI PARADISE, Dispenser General License No. 325, 1215 South Kihei Road, Unit 1, Kihei, Maui, Hawaii.

Count 1. On September 24, 2011 at approximately 7:47 p.m., SUSHI PARADISE, INC. dba SUSHI PARADISE, a dispenser general licensee, did, through its employee, sell, serve, or furnish liquor to a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

D. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2012-42, PLEA: NO CONTEST

In the matter of the accusation against RAINING KIND LLC dba LAS PINATAS OF MAUI, Restaurant Beer & Wine License No. 361, 395 Dairy Road, Suite J, Kahului, Maui, Hawaii.

Count 1. On October 8, 2011 at approximately 6:15 p.m., RAINING KIND LLC dba LAS PINATAS OF MAUI, a restaurant beer and wine licensee, did, through its employee, sell, serve, or furnish liquor to a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

E. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2012-43, PLEA: NO CONTEST

In the matter of the accusation against TOPIA FOODS CORPORATION dba AMIGO'S AUTHENTIC MEXICAN FOOD II, Dispenser General License No. 278, 333 Dairy Road, Suite 110, Kahului, Maui, Hawaii.

Count 1. On October 8, 2011 at approximately 6:39 p.m., TOPIA FOODS CORPORATION dba AMIGO'S AUTHENTIC MEXICAN FOOD II, a dispenser general licensee, did, through its employee, sell, serve, or furnish liquor to a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.
