Chair and Members:

Your Policy and Intergovernmental Affairs Committee, having met on February 25, 2013, makes reference to County Communication 13-67, from the Chief of Police, informing the Council of the acquisition of a 2005 Nissan Altima from the State Department of the Attorney General, pursuant to Resolution 90-82.

Your Committee notes Chapter 712A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, authorizes the State to distribute to any local or state government entity, municipality, or law enforcement agency within the State a share of funds or property seized by the County and forfeited to the State, provided the money and property are used for law enforcement purposes. Resolution 90-82 authorizes the Mayor or his authorized representative to receive such monies or property, provided any property accepted is reported to the Council within 60 days of acceptance.

Your Committee notes the communication states the estimated value of the vehicle is \$7,885.

According to a Sergeant from the Department of Police, the vehicle has been placed into the Department of Police's inventory. He further noted forfeited vehicles are used for educational and law enforcement purposes, and this type of vehicle will meet the goals and objectives of the Department.

Your Committee voted 9-0 to recommend filing of the communication. Committee Chair Hokama, Vice-Chair Couch, and members Baisa, Carroll, Cochran, Crivello, Guzman, Victorino, and White voted "aye".


Your Policy and Intergovernmental Affairs Committee RECOMMENDS that County Communication 13-67 be FILED.
