I. HEARINGS BEFORE THE BOARD:

A. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2012-45, PLEA: NO CONTEST

In the matter of the accusation against SAIGON SEAFOOD, LLC dba SAIGON SEAFOOD, Dispenser General License No. 167, 222 Papalaua Street, Units 100-103, Lahaina, Maui, Hawaii.

Count 1. On November 18, 2011 at approximately 6:59 p.m., SAIGON SEAFOOD, LLC dba SAIGON SEAFOOD, a dispenser general licensee, did, through its employee, sell, serve, or furnish liquor to a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

B. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2012-46, PLEA: NO CONTEST

In the matter of the accusation against CMSB L.L.C. dba KAHULUI ALE HOUSE, Restaurant General License No. 299, 355 East Kamehameha Avenue, Space A-11, Kahului, Maui, Hawaii.

Count 1. On August 20, 2011 and August 21, 2011 between the approximate times of 9:30 p.m. and 1:59 a.m., CMSB L.L.C. dba KAHULUI ALE HOUSE, a restaurant general licensee, did, through its employee(s), sell, serve, or furnish liquor to, or allow the consumption of liquor by a patron, who was at the time under the influence of liquor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(B) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(B) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

- Count 3. On August 20, 2011 and August 21, 2011 between the approximate times of 9:30 p.m. and 1:59 a.m., CMSB L.L.C. dba KAHULUI ALE HOUSE, a restaurant general licensee, did, through its employee(s), knowingly permit a patron, who was at the time under the influence of liquor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, to be or remain in or on the licensed premises, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(5) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(5) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

C. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2013-13, PLEA: NO CONTEST

In the matter of the accusation against CMSB L.L.C. dba KAHULUI ALE HOUSE, Restaurant General License No. 299, 355 East Kamehameha Avenue, Space A-11, Kahului, Maui, Hawaii.

- Count 1. On February 19, 2012 and February 20, 2012 between the approximate times of 11:00 p.m. and 1:18 a.m., CMSB L.L.C. dba KAHULUI ALE HOUSE, a restaurant general licensee, did, through its employee(s), sell, serve, or furnish liquor to, or allow the consumption of liquor by a patron, who was at the time under the influence of liquor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(B) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(B) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.
- Count 2. On February 19, 2012 and February 20, 2012 between the approximate times of 11:00 p.m. and 1:18 a.m., CMSB L.L.C. dba KAHULUI ALE HOUSE, a restaurant general licensee, did, through its employee(s), knowingly permit a patron, who was at the time under the influence of liquor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, to be or remain in or on the licensed premises, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(5) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(5) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.
