Chair and Members:

Your Infrastructure and Environmental Management Committee, having met on June 17, 2013, makes reference to County Communication 13-35, from Councilmember Mike White, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.60.042, MAUI COUNTY CODE, TO ESTABLISH A CROSSWALK ON BALDWIN AVENUE FRONTING PAIA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND TO AMEND THE DESCRIPTION OF THE CROSSWALK ON BALDWIN AVENUE FRONTING ALFRED 'FLAKO' BOTEILHO, SR., GYM".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to codify and establish an existing crosswalk fronting Paia Elementary School and amend the description of the crosswalk fronting the Alfred "Flako" Boteilho, Sr., Gym to reflect current geographic references.

Your Committee notes that this matter was reviewed by the Traffic Safety Council pursuant to Section 2.36.020, Maui County Code. In correspondence dated March 15, 2013, the Traffic Safety Council reported its support of the proposed bill.

According to the Director of Public Works, two existing crosswalks on Baldwin Avenue in upper Paia require modifications.

One crosswalk fronting the Alfred "Flako" Boteilho, Sr., Gym references a street name that no longer exists. Pedestrian traffic in the area required a recent slight relocation of this crosswalk.

The other crosswalk, the Paia School crosswalk, was never codified. This crosswalk may need to be relocated to a more central location after recent construction on the school campus.

The Director of Public Works stated that his department has been actively engaged with the community and the school in determining the proper location for these two crosswalks, and is in support of the proposed bill.

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.60.042,
MAUI COUNTY CODE, TO ESTABLISH A CROSSWALK ON BALDWIN
AVENUE FRONTING PAIA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND TO AMEND
THE DESCRIPTION OF THE CROSSWALK ON BALDWIN AVENUE
FRONTING ALFRED "FLAKO" BOTEILHO, SR., GYM

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Section 10.60.042, Maui County Code, is amended by amending
subsection C to read as follows:

"C. Makawao District. Pedestrian crosswalks are established in the
Makawao district at the following locations:

1. Not less than ten feet in width on that portion of Baldwin
Avenue, in Lower Paia, opposite Dr. Richard Y. Ikeda's dental office
situated in the S. Ikeda Store building;

2. Not less than twelve feet in width on that portion across
Baldwin Avenue, Upper Paia, [the centerline of the crosswalk being one
hundred fifty feet south of the Paia Theater road;] fronting the
Alfred "Flako" Boteilho, Sr., Gym;

3. Not less than twelve feet in width at Haiku, from the
Catholic Church to the parking area;

4. Not less than twelve feet in width on that portion of
Baldwin Avenue, in Lower Paia, fronting the U.S. Post Office-Bank of
Hawaii building;

5. Not less than twelve feet in width on that portion of
Baldwin Avenue, in upper Paia fronting on the Doris Todd Memorial
Christian Day School;

6. Not less than twelve feet in width on that portion of
Makawao Avenue in Makawao fronting the Makawao Library;

7. Not less than eight feet in width on that portion of
Haleakala Highway in Pukalani, approximately forty feet west of Pukalani
Street;

8. On that portion of West Kuiaha Road, approximately one
thousand one hundred feet in the makai direction from the intersection of
Haiku Road and West Kuiaha Road;

9. On that portion of Makawao Avenue fronting Makawao Post Office and being immediately east of the post office driveway;

10. On that portion of Baldwin Avenue fronting the Paia Mill Office Building, approximately six hundred fifty feet south of Puakou Place[.];

11. On that portion of Baldwin Avenue in Upper Paia fronting Paia Elementary School."

SECTION 2. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored. In printing this bill, the County Clerk need not include the brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
