NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Council of the County of Maui, State of Hawaii, on Tuesday, May 27, 2014, beginning at 9:00 a.m., or soon thereafter, in the Council Chamber, 8th Floor, Kalana O Maui Building, 200 South High Street, Wailuku, Maui, Hawaii, for the purpose of receiving testimony on the following:

1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2014 TO JUNE 30, 2015".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to appropriate estimated revenues for the operating and capital improvement budget for the County of Maui for Fiscal Year ("FY") 2015. Incorporated within the proposed bill are General Budget Provisions; Appendix A, which lists Grant Revenues – Schedule of Grants by Department, and Special Purpose Revenues – Schedule of Revolving/Special Funds; Appendix B, which is the Schedule of Fees, Rates, Assessments, and Taxes; and Attachment B-1, which lists the County's concessions, leases, and licenses by department.

2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE CAPITAL PROGRAM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2015".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to set forth the Capital Program for FY 2015 through FY 2020. Incorporated within the proposed bill are Appendix A-1, a report entitled "COUNTY OF MAUI, CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

REPORT, AS OF MARCH 31, 2014", which lists all pending capital improvement projects and appropriations, except for Water Fund projects, as of March 31, 2014; Appendix A-2, a report entitled "County of Maui, Statement of Appropriations and Expenditures, Capital Improvement Program by District, Fiscal Year Ending 6/30/2014 - as of 03/31/2014", which includes pending Department of Water Supply capital improvement projects and appropriations as of March 31, 2014; and Appendix B, which is the proposed Capital Program for FY 2015 through FY 2020.

3. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF TWENTY-ONE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY-THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$21,823,000) AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS TO PAY ALL OR A PART OF THE COST OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS OF AND FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI; FIXING THE FORM, DENOMINATIONS AND CERTAIN OTHER FEATURES OF SUCH BONDS AND PROVIDING FOR THEIR SALE; AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO DETERMINE CERTAIN DETAILS OF THE BONDS; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF A LIKE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF SUCH BONDS; AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER ACTIONS RELATED TO THE ISSUANCE, SALE AND DELIVERY OF SAID BONDS".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to authorize the issuance of general obligation bonds for various capital improvement projects.

4. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THAT PART OF THE PROCEEDS OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI HERETOFORE ISSUED IS IN EXCESS OF THE AMOUNTS REQUIRED FOR THE PURPOSES FOR WHICH SUCH BONDS WERE INITIALLY ISSUED, OR MAY OR SHOULD NOT BE APPLIED TO THOSE PURPOSES, AND DIRECTING SUCH PROCEEDS TO OTHER PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS OR AUTHORIZED PURPOSES OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to reauthorize the use of lapsed bond proceeds of \$1,210,000 for the Public Safety Radio System Replacement, and \$3,500,000 for the Molokai Baseyard capital improvement projects.

5. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI TO ENTER INTO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENTS FOR LOANS FROM THE STATE OF HAWAII'S WATER POLLUTION CONTROL REVOLVING FUND FOR VARIOUS WASTEWATER PROJECTS, FISCAL YEAR 2015 BUDGET ORDINANCE".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to authorize the Mayor to enter into intergovernmental agreements to finance the following wastewater projects from

the State of Hawaii's Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund Loans: Paia Wastewater Pump Station Force Main Replacement, with funds not to exceed \$5,100,000; South Maui Recycled Water Distribution System Expansion, with funds not to exceed \$1,044,000; and Waiehu Wastewater Pump Station Force Main Replacement, with funds not to exceed \$1,300,000.

6. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI TO ENTER INTO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENTS FOR LOANS FROM THE STATE OF HAWAII'S DRINKING WATER TREATMENT REVOLVING LOAN FUND FOR VARIOUS WATER PROJECTS, FISCAL YEAR 2015 BUDGET ORDINANCE".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to authorize the Mayor to enter into intergovernmental agreements to finance the following water projects from the State of Hawaii's Drinking Water Treatment Revolving Loan Fund: Omaopio 2.1 MG Tank Replacement, with funds not to exceed \$4,000,000; Lahainaluna Road Booster-Phase 1, with funds not to exceed \$1,700,000; Wailuku Heights Tank 30 Booster, with funds not to exceed \$1,200,000; Source Generator Installation-4 sites, with funds not to exceed \$1,200,000; Kualapuu MCC Upgrades, with funds not to exceed \$500,000; and Honokahua Well C Exploratory Well Construction, with funds not to exceed \$2,000,000.

7. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 2.68, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO VOTER REGISTRATION DATA".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to update voter registration computer tape fees and other obsolete references in Chapter 2.68, Maui County Code, and incorporate other clarifications.

Copies of the proposed bills are on file in the Office of the County Clerk, 7th Floor, Kalana O Maui Building, 200 South High Street, Wailuku, Maui, for use and examination by the public during regular business hours.

Each testifier shall be allowed to speak for three minutes. If additional time is requested, the testifier shall be allowed one minute to conclude their testimony. No further oral testimony by the testifier shall be permitted. An individual's request to testify shall be deemed withdrawn if the individual does not answer when called to testify.

For remote testimony sites, oral testimony may be received by telephone from each of the Council district offices noted above. If the audio connection between the meeting site in the Council Chamber and any of the remote testimony sites is lost, the public hearing in the Council Chamber will still continue. Members of the public interested in information about offering testimony at the public hearing from a remote testimony site may contact the Office of the County Clerk (808-270-7748) prior to the public hearing. While oral testimony is being received the district offices cannot provide other services. The audio connection will be terminated after all oral testimony has been received.

To ensure its distribution prior to the public hearing, written testimony must be received, emailed (county.clerk@mauicounty.us), or faxed (808-270-7171) to the Office of the County Clerk at least 24 hours prior to the public hearing. If written testimony is submitted at the public hearing, 15 copies are requested.

Individuals who intend to attend the public hearing and who have disabilities requiring special assistance should call the Office of the County Clerk at 270-7748, at least three days in advance.
