ORAL OR WRITTEN TESTIMONY on any agenda item will be accepted. Each testifier shall be allowed to speak for three minutes on each item. If additional time is requested, the testifier shall be allowed one minute to conclude the testimony on the item. These time limits may be modified pursuant to the Rules of the Council, provided a modification would apply equally to all testifiers and all items. No further oral testimony by the testifier on the item shall be permitted. An individual's request to testify shall be deemed withdrawn if the individual does not answer when called to testify. To ensure its distribution prior to the meeting, written testimony must be received in the Office of Council Services at least 24 hours prior to the meeting; provided, that if a meeting will be held on a Monday, written testimony shall be received by 12:00 noon on the business day preceding the meeting. If written testimony is submitted at the meeting site, 16 copies are requested to ensure distribution at the meeting.

REMOTE TESTIMONY SITES: Oral testimony may be received by telephone from each of the Council district offices noted above. If the audio connection between the meeting site in the Council Chamber and any of the remote testimony sites is lost, the meeting in the Council Chamber will still continue. Members of the public interested in information about offering testimony on an agenda item from a remote testimony site may contact the Office of Council Services prior to the meeting. While oral testimony is being received, the district offices cannot provide other services. The audio connection will be terminated after all oral testimony has been received.

IEM-38 AMENDING CHAPTER 10.28, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO TRAFFIC-CONTROL DEVICES

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication 14-61, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10.28, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO TRAFFIC-CONTROL DEVICES". The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Maui Traffic Code by including references to "Flashing Yellow Arrow" as an indication for permissive left turn movements at traffic signals, and "rectangular rapid flashing beacons" and "in-pavement roadway lights" as additional types of warning lights at crosswalks.
2. Correspondence dated April 7, 2014, from Director of Public Works, transmitting comments on the proposed bill from the Maui County Traffic Safety Council.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 14-61 and other related action.

IEM-23 LOADING ZONE – KING KAMEHAMEHA III ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ON FRONT STREET (LAHAINA)

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication 13-300, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a proposed bill to establish the loading zone on Front Street fronting King Kamehameha III Elementary School as an "active" loading zone and to prohibit unattended vehicles in the loading zone.
2. Correspondence dated May 9, 2014, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a revised proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.56A.010, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO LOADING ZONES". The purpose of the revised proposed bill is to establish the loading zone on Front Street fronting King Kamehameha III Elementary School as an "active" loading zone for immediate loading and unloading and to prohibit unattended vehicles in the loading zone.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the revised proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 13-300 and other related action.

IEM-44 RENAMING OF "WAIKOLOA" ROAD TO "WAIKALOA" ROAD IN HANA, MAUI, HAWAII

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 14-112, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE RENAMING OF WAIKOLOA ROAD, HANA, MAUI, HAWAII". The purpose of the proposed bill is to correct the misspelled road name by renaming "Waikoloa Road" to "Waikaloa Road".

IEM-35 ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF ROAD WIDENING LOT FOR THE CORYELL-HUGHES SUBDIVISION

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 13-400, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF A ROAD WIDENING LOT FOR THE CORYELL-HUGHES SUBDIVISION, PURSUANT TO SECTION 3.44.015, MAUI COUNTY CODE". The purpose of the proposed resolution is to accept Lot 1-E along Piihola Road, consisting of 0.336 acres, identified as Tax Map Key Number (2) 2-4-013:040, Makawao, Maui, dedicated in compliance with the requirements of Subdivision File Number 2.3126.

IEM-43**AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF ROAD LOT B-3 IN HAIKU, MAUI, HAWAII, PURSUANT TO SECTION 3.44.015, MAUI COUNTY CODE**

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 14-98, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF ROAD LOT B-3 IN HAIKU, MAUI, HAWAII, PURSUANT TO SECTION 3.44.015, MAUI COUNTY CODE". The purpose of the proposed resolution is to accept Lot B-3, consisting of 0.460 acres, identified as Tax Map Key Numbers (2) 2-7-010:047 and (2) 2-7-010:058, as it comprises a portion of Haiku Road that passes through private property.
