*ORAL OR WRITTEN TESTIMONY on any agenda item will be accepted. Each testifier shall be allowed to speak for three minutes on each item. If additional time is requested, the testifier shall be allowed one minute to conclude the testimony on the item. These time limits may be modified pursuant to the Rules of the Council, provided a modification would apply equally to all testifiers and all items. No further oral testimony by the testifier on the item shall be permitted. An individual's request to testify shall be deemed withdrawn if the individual does not answer when called to testify. To ensure its distribution prior to the meeting, written testimony must be received in the Office of Council Services at least 24 hours prior to the meeting; provided, that if a meeting will be held on a Monday, written testimony shall be received by 12:00 noon on the business day preceding the meeting. If written testimony is submitted at the meeting site, 16 copies are requested to ensure distribution at the meeting.*

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**BF-13(3) AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND PROGRAM ANNUAL PLAN**

**DESCRIPTION:** The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 14-154, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:

1. The Department of Housing and Human Concerns' 2014 Affordable Housing Fund Program Annual Plan.
2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX A OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2015 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO PART II, SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUES – SCHEDULE OF REVOLVING/SPECIAL FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015, AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND, NA HALE O MAUI KAHOMA PROJECT". The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year ("FY") 2015 Budget, relating to the Affordable Housing Fund, by adding a proviso of \$780,000, for the Na Hale O Maui Kahoma Project – Na Hale O Maui.
3. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX A OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2015 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO PART II, SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUES – SCHEDULE OF REVOLVING/SPECIAL FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015, AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND, BUILDING HOUSES, BUILDING HOPE PROJECT". The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2015 Budget, relating to the Affordable Housing Fund, by adding a proviso of \$1,400,000, for the Building Houses, Building Hope Project – Habitat for Humanity Maui, Inc.
4. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX A OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2015 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO PART II, SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUES – SCHEDULE OF REVOLVING/SPECIAL FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015, AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND, KULAMALU AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROJECT". **BF-117 AMENDING FY 2015 BUDGET: AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND (HALE LOKELANI OHANA PROJECT)**

**DESCRIPTION:** The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 14-155, from the Budget Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX A OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2015 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO PART II, SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUES – SCHEDULE OF REVOLVING/SPECIAL FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015, AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND, HALE LOKELANI OHANA PROJECT". The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2015 Budget, relating to the Affordable Housing Fund, by adding a proviso of \$400,000 for the Hale Lokelani Ohana Project – Lokelani Ohana.
