Chair and Members:

Your Infrastructure and Environmental Management Committee, having met on June 16, 2014, makes reference to County Communication 14-112, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE RENAMING OF WAIKOLOA ROAD, HANA, MAUI, HAWAII".

The purpose of the proposed bill is to correct a misspelled road name, in Hana, Maui, Hawaii, by renaming "Waikoloa Road" to "Waikaloa Road".

Pursuant to Section 2.38.090, Maui County Code, the Director of Public Works transmitted the recommendations of the Commission on Naming Streets, Parks, and Facilities to rename "Waikoloa Road" to "Waikaloa Road". The Maui County Cultural Resources Commission also recommended approval of the name change.

Your Committee noted the significance of place names and the importance of their meaning in Hawaiian culture. The long-held sentiment that the appropriate name of the road should read "Waikaloa" is supported by references in historical documents, chants, songs, and the oral histories of kupuna.

Your Committee voted 6-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading and filing of the communication. Committee Chair Cochran, Vice-Chair Crivello, and members Carroll, Couch, Guzman and Hokama voted "aye". Committee member White was excused.

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE RENAMING
OF WAIKOLOA ROAD, HANA, MAUI, HAWAII


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Chapter 2.38 of the Maui County Code, relating to Commission on Naming Streets, Parks, and Facilities, requires council approval of street renaming by ordinance.

SECTION 2. The Council approves the recommendation of the Commission on Naming Streets, Parks, and Facilities renaming Waikoloa Road to Waikaloa Road.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
