ORAL OR WRITTEN TESTIMONY on any agenda item will be accepted. Each testifier shall be allowed to speak for three minutes on each item. If additional time is requested, the testifier shall be allowed one minute to conclude the testimony on the item. These time limits may be modified pursuant to the Rules of the Council, provided a modification would apply equally to all testifiers and all items. No further oral testimony by the testifier on the item shall be permitted. An individual's request to testify shall be deemed withdrawn if the individual does not answer when called to testify. To ensure its distribution prior to the meeting, written testimony must be received in the Office of Council Services at least 24 hours prior to the meeting; provided, that if a meeting will be held on a Monday, written testimony shall be received by 12:00 noon on the business day preceding the meeting. If written testimony is submitted at the meeting site, 16 copies are requested to ensure distribution at the meeting.

REMOTE TESTIMONY SITES: Oral testimony may be received by telephone from each of the Council district offices noted above. If the audio connection between the meeting site in the Council Chamber and any of the remote testimony sites is lost, the meeting in the Council Chamber will still continue. Members of the public interested in information about offering testimony on an agenda item from a remote testimony site may contact the Office of Council Services prior to the meeting. While oral testimony is being received, the district offices cannot provide other services. The audio connection will be terminated after all oral testimony has been received.

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BF-113 NOTICE OF TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS FROM COUNTYWIDE COSTS - GENERAL COSTS TO VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS

- DESCRIPTION:** The Committee is in receipt of the following:
1. County Communication 14-144, from the Director of Finance, informing the Council of the transfer of appropriations from Countywide Costs, General Costs, to various departments, to cover the Fiscal Year 2014 bargaining units' salary increases. The transfers from Countywide Costs, General Costs, included: (1) Department of the Corporation Counsel, \$32,856; (2) Department of Finance, \$206,585; (3) Department of Fire and Public Safety, \$773,200; (4) Department of Housing and Human Concerns, \$98,950; (5) Department of Management, \$92,787; (6) Office of the Mayor, \$66,331; (7) Department of Police, \$1,608,743; (8) Department of the Prosecuting Attorney, \$72,138; and (9) Department of Public Works, \$148,073.
 2. County Communication 14-205, from the Acting Director of Finance, informing the Council of the transfer of appropriations from Countywide Costs, General Costs, to various departments, to cover the cost of Fiscal Year 2014 bargaining units' salary increases. The transfers from Countywide Costs, General Costs, included: (1) Department of Police, \$94,523; (2) Department of Fire and Public Safety, \$3,983; (3) Department of Parks and Recreation – General Fund, \$490; Department of Parks and Recreation – Golf Fund, \$2,487; and (4) Department of Environmental Management – Solid Waste Fund, \$2,586.

BF-125 AMENDING FISCAL YEAR 2015 BUDGET: ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT REVOLVING FUND

- DESCRIPTION:** The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 14-223, from the Economic Development Director, transmitting the following:
1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX A OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2015 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO PART II, SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUES – SCHEDULE OF REVOLVING/SPECIAL FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT REVOLVING FUND". The purpose of the proposed bill is to appropriate funds from the Economic Development Revolving Fund, pursuant to Chapter 3.81, Maui County Code, for the following: (1) Uptown Service, Inc., to renovate and convert its car wash facility to a restaurant called "Da Car Wash Café", \$200,000; (2) Alpha, Inc., to purchase a National T-32 drill rig to offer lower cost drilling to deep well projects, \$125,000; (3) Maui Innovation Group LLC, for medical care management software to better manage patient care, \$175,000; (4) HNU Photonics LLC, for infrastructure and equipment for

- stem cell research, \$250,000; and (5) Aumakua Holdings, Inc, for equipment for a Maui Brewing Co. facility in Kihei to add beverages and increase exportation, \$250,000.
- 2. A report entitled "Maui County Economic Development Revolving Fund (EDRF), First Round Grant Reviews, Report to the Mayor, August 10, 2014."

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 14-223 and other related action.
