**A. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2014-33, PLEA: NO CONTEST**

**In the matter of the accusation against SLY MONGOOSE, INC. dba SLY MONGOOSE, Dispenser General License No. 275, 1036 Limahana Place, Lahaina, Maui, Hawaii.**

Count 1. On April 19, 2013 at approximately 11:59 p.m., SLY MONGOOSE, INC. dba SLY MONGOOSE, a dispenser general licensee, did, through its employee(s), sell, serve, or furnish liquor to, or allow the consumption of liquor by a patron, who was at the time under the influence of liquor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(B) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(B) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

**B. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2014-36, PLEA: NO CONTEST**

**In the matter of the accusation against MISAKI'S, INC. dba MISAKI'S, INC., Retail General License No. 062, 78 Ala Malama Street, Kaunakakai, Molokai, Hawaii.**

Count 1. On August 18, 2012 at approximately 11:10 a.m., MISAKI'S, INC. dba MISAKI'S, INC., a retail general licensee, did, through its employee, sell or furnish liquor to a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

**C. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2015-1, PLEA: NO CONTEST**

**In the matter of the accusation against 888, INC. dba LONGHI'S, Restaurant General License No. 226, 888 Front Street, Lahaina, Maui, Hawaii.**

Count 1. On August 23, 2013 between the approximate times of 12 midnight and 1:45 a.m., 888, INC. dba LONGHI'S, a restaurant general licensee, did, through its employee(s), sell, serve, or furnish liquor to, or allow the consumption of liquor by a patron, who was at the time under the influence of liquor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(B) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(B) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

Count 4. On August 23, 2013 between the approximate times of 12 midnight and 1:45 a.m., 888, INC. dba LONGHI'S, a restaurant general licensee, did, through its employee(s), sell, serve, or furnish liquor to, or allow the consumption of liquor by a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

**D. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2015-2, PLEA: NO CONTEST**

**In the matter of the accusation against S&M WAILEA LLC dba MALA WAILEA, Dispenser General License No. 207, 3700 Wailea Alanui Drive, Wailea, Maui, Hawaii.**

Count 1. On December 31, 2013 between the approximate times of 11:00 p.m. and 11:50 p.m., S&M WAILEA LLC dba MALA WAILEA, a dispenser general licensee, did, through its employee(s), sell, serve, or furnish liquor to, or allow the consumption of liquor by a patron, who was at the time under the influence of liquor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(B) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(B) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

Count 4. On December 31, 2013 between the approximate times of

11:00 p.m. and 11:50 p.m., S&M WAILEA LLC dba MALA WAILEA, a dispenser general licensee, did, through its employee(s), sell, serve, or furnish liquor to, or allow the consumption of liquor by a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

**E. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2015-3 PLEA: NO CONTEST**

**In the matter of the accusation against HAUI INC. dba HAUI'S LIFE'S A BEACH, Dispenser General License No. 022, 1913 South Kihei Road, Space E, Kihei, Maui, Hawaii.**

- Count 1. On June 7, 2013 and June 8, 2013 between the approximate times of 11:00 p.m. and 1:09 a.m., HAUI INC. dba HAUI'S LIFE'S A BEACH, a dispenser general licensee, did, through its employee(s), sell, serve, or furnish liquor to, or allow the consumption of liquor by Patron No. 1, who was at the time under the influence of liquor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(B) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(B) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.
- Count 2. On June 7, 2013 and June 8, 2013 between the approximate times of 11:00 p.m. and 1:09 a.m., HAUI INC. dba HAUI'S LIFE'S A BEACH, a dispenser general licensee, did, through its employee(s), sell, serve, or furnish liquor to, or allow the consumption of liquor by Patron No. 2, who was at the time under the influence of liquor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(B) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(B) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.
- Count 3. On June 7, 2013 and June 8, 2013 between the approximate times of 11:00 p.m. and 1:09 a.m., HAUI INC. dba HAUI'S LIFE'S A BEACH, a dispenser general licensee, did, through its employee(s), sell, serve, or furnish liquor to, or allow the consumption of liquor by Patron No. 3, who was at the time under the influence of liquor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the

Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(B) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(B) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.
