ORAL OR WRITTEN TESTIMONY on any agenda item will be accepted. Each testifier shall be allowed to speak for three minutes on each item. If additional time is requested, the testifier shall be allowed one minute to conclude the testimony on the item. These time limits may be modified pursuant to the Rules of the Council, provided a modification would apply equally to all testifiers and all items. No further oral testimony by the testifier on the item shall be permitted. An individual's request to testify shall be deemed withdrawn if the individual does not answer when called to testify. To ensure its distribution prior to the meeting, written testimony must be received in the Office of Council Services at least 24 hours prior to the meeting; provided, that if a meeting will be held on a Monday, written testimony shall be received by 12:00 noon on the business day preceding the meeting. If written testimony is submitted at the meeting site, 12 copies are requested to ensure distribution at the meeting.

AMENDING FISCAL YEAR 2015 BUDGET: OLD HALEAKALA HIGHWAY AND MAKANI ROAD PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 14-273, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:

1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2015 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES; MAKAWAO-PUKALANI-KULA COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, ROAD IMPROVEMENTS, OLD HALEAKALA HIGHWAY AND MAKANI ROAD PAVEMENT REHABILITATION; TOTAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT APPROPRIATIONS; AND TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)". The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2015 Budget by: (1) increasing Bond/Lapsed Bond Fund by \$1,381,750 from \$52,378,582 to \$53,760,332; and (2) adding a \$1,381,750 appropriation from the Bond Fund for the Makawao-Pukalani-Kula Community Plan Area, Road Improvements, for the Old Haleakala Highway and Makani Road Pavement Rehabilitation project.
2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4130, BILL NO. 34 (2014), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI (OLD HALEAKALA HIGHWAY AND MAKANI ROAD PAVEMENT REHABILITATION)". The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2015 general obligation bond authorization ordinance by adding a \$1,381,750 appropriation for the Makawao-Pukalani-Kula Community Plan, Road Improvements, for the Old Haleakala Highway and Makani Road Pavement Rehabilitation project.
3. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2015 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANT REVENUE – SCHEDULE OF GRANTS BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS (FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION/INTERMODAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION EFFICIENCY ACT (ISTEA) HIGHWAY AND OTHER TRANSPORTATION GRANTS)". The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Appendix A of the Fiscal Year 2015 Budget by increasing the appropriation for the Department of Public Works, Federal Highway Administration/Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA) Highway and other Transportation Grants by \$3,527,000, from \$10,626,000 to \$14,153,000.

AMENDING FISCAL YEAR 2015 BUDGET: WAILEA ALANUI DRIVE AND WAILEA IKE DRIVE PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 14-274, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:

1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2015 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES; KIHEI-MAKENA COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, ROAD IMPROVEMENTS, WAILEA ALANUI DRIVE AND WAILEA IKE DRIVE PAVEMENT REHABILITATION; TOTAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT APPROPRIATIONS; AND TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)". The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2015 Budget by (1) increasing Bond/Lapsed Bond Fund by \$1,562,000, from \$52,378,582 to \$53,940,582; and (2) increasing a

\$1,562,000 appropriation from the Bond Fund, for the Kihei Makena Community Plan Area, Road Improvements, for the Wailea Alanui Drive and Wailea Ike Drive Pavement Rehabilitation project.

2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4130, BILL NO. 34 (2014), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI (WAILEA ALANUI DRIVE AND WAILEA IKE DRIVE PAVEMENT REHABILITATION)". The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2015 general obligation bond authorization ordinance by increasing the appropriation by \$1,562,000, from \$608,000 to \$2,170,000, for the Kihei Makena Community Plan Area, Road Improvements, for the Wailea Alanui Drive and Wailea Ike Drive Pavement Rehabilitation project.
3. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2015 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANT REVENUE – SCHEDULE OF GRANTS BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS (FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION/INTERMODAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION EFFICIENCY ACT (ISTEA) HIGHWAY AND OTHER TRANSPORTATION GRANTS)".
